FACT SHEET

A total of ten (10) bands and vocal groups and/or individual entertainers will be selected to perform. Prizes will be presented to the top two bands, top two vocal groups, and two top individual performers.

The competition will be on an outdoor stage at Idlewild Park from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. Saturday, April 14, 2007.

A voice reinforcement P.A., mixing board, an amplifier, two microphones, and main speakers will be provided. You will be responsible for all other equipment.

Individual entertainers must be under 19 years old.

Bands or vocal groups must have at least 2/3 of their members under 18 years old to be eligible to compete.

Any style music will be considered. Tune In To Kids is a family event, the lyrics and presentation must be acceptable in that environment. NO profanity or offensive behavior allowed. Violation will result in IMMEDIATE disqualification.

Fill out an application in its entirety. Be sure to fill out the stage diagram fully.

Submit a list of songs to be performed and a CD or audiocassette tape containing the 20 minutes of music that you will be performing at the event. You will not be judged by the quality of the sound recording, but entirely by the musical performance. Vocal groups are responsible for bringing their own non-vocal CD to the event for their performance. NO music will be provided!

1. You will be notified by **phone and email** no later April 1, 2007.
2. You must attend a pre-performance meeting at the Teen stage on April 14, 2007 at 10:30a
3. Please be prepared to perform at the time assigned to your group. Your time will be between 11:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.
4. Please organize your performance so as to not exceed 15 minutes in length.
5. Follow the direction of the music production team. This will help the event run smoothly. Being properly prepared for your performance and the level of professionalism you show will count toward the judges' final decision.
6. The winners will be announced at the end of the competition. Please be prepared to stay all day.
