**Smoking:** Thank you for not smoking!

**Free Shuttle Service:** Shuttle service will make round trips from Reno High School to the Main Entrance of Idlewild Park every 10-15 minutes. The last shuttle will leave the Park at 6:00 p.m.

**Traffic:** The Park will be CLOSED to traffic from 9:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. (City of Reno Regulation).

**Information Tents:** Look for the yellow flags on top of the four (4) Information Tents which are located throughout the Park and identified by a “?” on the map. Visit the Information Tents for your goodie bag, exhibitor locations, extra maps, performance schedules, Prize Drawing tickets, entry forms for the \$500 Grand Prize activity, and any other questions you may have.

**Hosts:** Look for anyone in an orange vest if you need help or have questions.

**First Aid:** Located by the Totem Pole on Main St./Cowan Dr. (see truck with a red cross on map)

**Lost and Found:** Located at the Information Tent at the Main Entrance

**Restrooms:** See map - located throughout the Park and in the California Building

**Goodie Bags:** Pick up at any Information Tent located throughout the Park and identified by a “?” on the map
